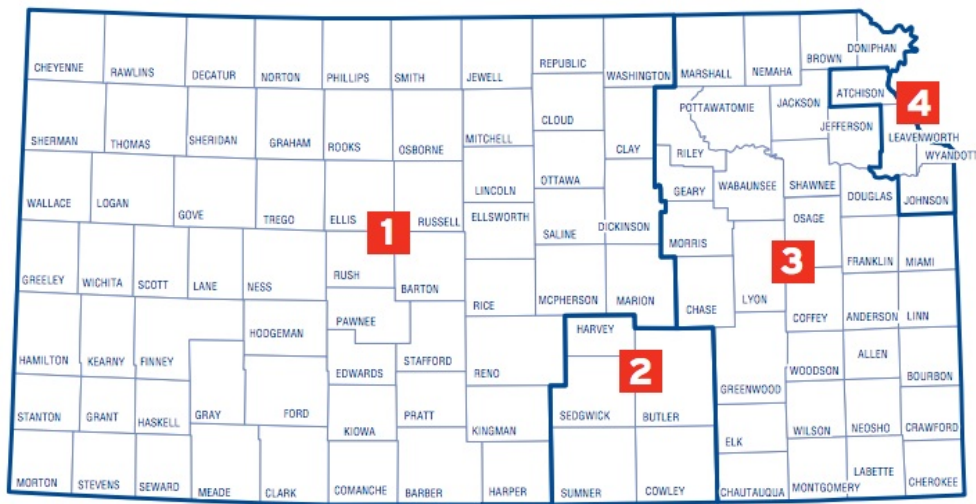

Use of Puppetry and Plays

This course discusses the importance of using puppetry and pretend play in the early child care setting. Included in the course are the definition of puppets and brief history of puppetry throughout the world. The discussion identifies different types of puppets and puppet stages and describes design ideas and construction methods. This course also presents ideas for sound and lighting, as well as a discussion of developing and implementing skits and plays that are appropriate for the preschool classroom.



Learning Through Play

This course defines the term play and discusses different types of play. It also discusses the various reasons why play is necessary for children and the roles teachers perform when promoting learning through play.
