Healthy Oral Habits

Did you know lack of water can make a person feel tired? Next time you or the children start to feel sluggish or cranky, reach for water. Our bodies need water to function properly. Water is good for your whole body and won't damage your teeth like sugary drinks. A growing number of early child care programs are making drinking water available to young children whenever they wish. The goal is to increase water consumption each day and reduce children's dependence on juice or sweet beverages for hydration. Here are some tips for encouraging children to drink water during the day:

- 1. Make it fun: Let kids use single-use bendy, silly, or colored straws.
- 2. Keep it portable and available: Have water bottles that are labeled for each child and can be refilled easily at a water station so children do not get thirsty.
- Flavor it: Children that are used to drinking juice or pop might think water is too plain. Add fruit, such as lemons, orange slices or strawberries.

Technology and Children

Technology is everywhere. It's hard to imagine our lives without it. It makes our lives easier in many ways, but is technology beneficial or harmful to our children? Will allowing your child to watch TV or play on your phone while you take a shower or pick up the house damage their developing brain? Absolutely not! However, is it possible that too much technology is changing the way our children learn and focus? Experts suggest that too much exposure to technology can negativity impact both language and social emotional development. What can you do to find a healthy balance between family and technology?

- Monitor all technology: Test apps before children use them, play together, ask questions and engage in the experience with your child.
- 'Un-plug': Make a family pledge to 'un-plug' at the dinner table. Make a routine of unplugging all technology at least one hour before bed.
- Avoid using technology as a calming strategy: Find other ways to soothe your child and avoid distracting them with technology. Help them manage their emotions with communicating, counting/taking deep breaths and other self-regulating techniques.
- Develop a family technology plan: Decide as a family the amount of 'screen-time' for each member.
- Model healthy technology behavior- put your phone down and enjoy spending time together.

complete quarterly phone calls to child care programs. Some of the important information the CCR&Rs update when conducting phone calls includes the number of child care openings available, how many children are currently enrolled, the current cost of care for each age group of children and if the child care program offers care during non-traditional hours (evening, weekend, overnight).

The Child Care Aware of Kansas Provider Profile Registry, also known as a PPR, gives you the ability to enter information about your program, such as hours/days of operation, age group vacancies, rates, training hours, transportation options, and much more.

- Connecting with families looking for child care
- Emphasizing your special areas of experience and expertise

You can highlight your program with a picture tour for families (we know they love this feature!) but, be sure to obtain photo releases prior to uploading photos or include photos that do not show children's faces. reports are created to spotlight challenges experienced by hardworking child care professionals. Two recent reports include the <u>2018 Kansas Child</u> <u>Care Workforce Study and Child Care</u> <u>Profile</u> and the <u>2018 Child Care Supply</u> <u>Demand Report.</u> These reports would not be possible without child care professionals taking time to update their program information with us regularly.
