WHY DO I NEED TO UPDATE MY CHILD CARE PROVIDER PROFILE?

The information is used to inform parents about child care programs that have openings for their child(ren), based on the parent's needs. It's an efficient and informative way for parents to begin their child care search. In fact, over 13,000 families connect with us each year when they are looking for child care.

To keep information about child care current, Child Care Resource and Referral (CCR&R) Agencies complete quarterly phone calls to child care programs. Some of the important information the CCR&Rs update when conducting phone calls includes the number of child care openings available, how many children are currently enrolled, the current cost of care for each age group of children and if the child care program offers care during non-traditional hours (evening, weekend, overnight).

The information collected also helps to paint a picture for partners on how funding and support for early childhood programs can positively impact the future for Kansas children. Comprehensive, informative reports, such as the annual supply demand report, are created to spotlight challenges experienced by hardworking child care professionals.

These reports would not be possible without child care professionals taking time to update their program information with us regularly.

So, the next time the phone rings and it's your local CCR&R, take a few minutes and update your information. It benefits all of us!

Fun in the Sun!

Keep your family safe this summer by following these tips from the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP).

Babies under 6 months:

The two main recommendations from the AAP to prevent sunburn are to avoid sun exposure and to dress infants in lightweight long pants, long-sleeved shirts, and brimmed hats that shade the neck to prevent sunburn. However, when adequate clothing and shade are not available, parents can apply a minimal amount of sunscreen with at least 15 SPF (sun protection factor) to small areas, such as the infant's face. If an infant gets a sunburn, apply cool compresses to the affected area.

For All Other Children:

- The first, and best, line of defense against harmful ultraviolet radiation (UVR) exposure is covering up. Wear a hat with a three-inch brim or a bill facing forward, shatter resistant sunglasses (look for sunglasses that provide 97% -100% protection against both UVA and UVB rays), and clothing with a tight weave.
- Carefully follow the instructions on the sunscreen as application can vary
- Test for an allergy or sensitivity by applying a small amount of sunscreen and watch for a reaction before using for outdoor activities.
- Stay in the shade whenever possible, and limit sun exposure during the peak intensity hours - between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.
- On both sunny and cloudy days use a sunscreen with an SPF 15 or greater that protects against UVA and UVB rays.
- Reapply sunscreen every two hours or after swimming or sweating
- Use extra caution near water and sand (and even snow!) as they reflect UV rays and may result in sunburn more quickly. For more tips on sun and water safety, visit www.healthychildren.org
