*Note: This list is not all-inclusive, nor is it a guarantee that an application will be approved if only requesting items on this list. These are ideas or suggestions of requestable items. Tools shall not be requested but supplies to complete minor renovation projects are welcome to be requested. Providers are encouraged to request any items that would help their program achieve health and safety needs to mitigate COVID-19, fitting within the following definition:

- Any improvement or upgrade to a facility that is NOT specified under the definition of major renovation (directly following), may be considered a minor renovation, and may be allowed. Major renovation is defined as: (1) structural changes to the foundation, roof, floor, exterior or load-bearing walls of a facility, or the extension of a facility to increase its floor area; or (2) extensive alteration of a facility such as to significantly change its function and purpose, even if such renovation does not include any structural change.
