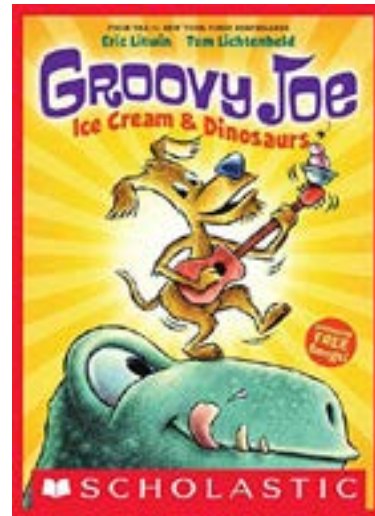

## Literacy and Children

When we think about the word literacy, we automatically think of reading. Literacy is so much more than reading and writing when it comes to early childhood. Introducing literacy to children in your care should include sharing and reading books along with talking about books and illustrations, being aware of print in your environment, and encouraging pre-writing skills.

When sharing a book together, ask questions! With young children, talk about what you see in the pictures. Point out and name characters you see on the pages. Follow the words with your finger so they can get the feel for left to right progression. Share books that rhyme. Repeat the rhymes and make your own silly combinations. Talking together with your children will make the books you share come alive.

Environmental print creates a unique opportunity to support literacy. Our world is full of signs. Young children are able to 'read' environmental print long before they are actually able to read. Point out signs in your neighborhood. Talk about labels on products in your home or while shopping. Ask your child to identify logos. You may be surprised how many they know! Encouraging print awareness will help children make the connection between letters and first efforts to read.

It is OKAY to scribble! Children learning to write will first learn with scribble. Lots and lots of scribbles. This early writing will build fine motor skills necessary for writing. Scribbling is also important in building hand-eye coordination. Encourage children to draw a picture, write a letter, or make a list. While these first scribbles may not look like much to an adult, they are forming a foundation for future literacy.

One of the most important things you can do for children in your care is the simplest: **READ**. Time after time research has shown, reading to children is one of the best things you can do to encourage literacy development. It is never too early to begin a habit of reading to children. Reading exposes children to words in turn enriching their own vocabulary and preparing them to pick up reading skills more easily and quickly. Point out words that you encounter everyday, narrate your moves as you spend time together throughout the day, and let them see you read for pleasure. As children get older, encourage them to read along with you and pretend to read to you. Point out pictures in their favorite books and ask questions. Make a habit of reading together everyday. Simple habits you form today with children in your care will help their future success in school.

Graduating from Drake University with a bachelor's degree in Political Science, Spanish and International Relations and a Master of Public Administration-Public Policy, Davydov has dedicated her career to issues of equity and family education and empowerment. Serving on and leading numerous coalitions, task forces and advisory boards, she has been a presenter at the state and national level.
