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

Online Training Opportunities

Methods of Enhancing Intellectual Development

This course familiarizes participants with the methods for enhancing intellectual development in children. It discusses brain development, how to motivate children to learn, and creativity's role in intellectual development, classroom management, and strategies for effective teaching.



This course provides early childhood teachers valuable information regarding math instruction in a preschool environment. The course discusses cognitive development in ONLINE LEARNING

young children, ways in which children learn, and the use of manipulatives to support emergent math skills. It describes the role of the National Council of Teachers of Mathematics (NCTM) in preschool math education and identifies focal points and focal point connections important in early math education. Considerations and strategies for using manipulatives in the classroom are presented and math activities that use manipulatives are detailed. A discussion of preschool assessment considerations and techniques is also included.

December

Circle Time

In this course, participants will learn about the use of circle time, effective circle time strategies and ideas for activities to use for specific skill development. Strategies will also discuss how to include parents in circle time activities.

Learning Styles

This course familiarizes participants with the major learning styles. It discusses how to determine children's learning styles and how to tailor activities to individual learning styles.
